## Presentation Guidelines

### Symposium Presentations

All symposia will be 60 minutes in total, with a minimum of 3 speakers. Preference will be given to symposia which cover the spectrum of basic to clinical science and those that include speakers from more than one research group. You will need to submit a working title for the symposium, a short statement (300 words maximum) outlining the learning objectives of the symposium and a pdf with the names of the presenters and their individual abstracts. Please see the Symposium Abstract Submission page for more details.

### Free Presentations

These are the traditional conference presentation format. Length: 10 minutes plus 5 minutes question time.

### Data Blitz Presentations

Data Blitz presentations require speakers to present an interesting finding from their research using a *maximum* of 5 power point slides. Length: 5 minutes plus 2 mins question time.

### Poster Presentations

Posters must be in "Portrait" orientation unless there is prior arrangement with the conference organisers. Maximum height: 110 cms and Maximum width: 80 cms.

### ECR Award Presentation

This presentation will be made by the awardee of the 'ECR Award'. Please see the ECR Award page for more details on the application process. Length: 20 minutes plus 10 minutes question time.
